Frequently Asked Questions.

1. What is Foundation English Test (FET)?

Developed by language experts from the British Council, this assessment has been piloted in diverse global markets. It evaluates English proficiency levels ranging from A1 to B1 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The test comprehensively assesses all language skills—listening, reading, writing, and speaking—and is administered via computer, incorporating a recorded speaking component.

2. What do I need to register for the test?

- Only a valid Government issued ID is accepted (i.e. Passport/National ID/Citizenship Card). Other identity documents are not accepted.
- A valid email and phone number
- There is no age limit to register for the FET Test.

3. What is the registration deadline?

Interested candidates are requested to register and pay for the FET test please go to our website for test dates and registration deadline. We cannot confirm the availability of seats after we reach full capacity.

4. What is the price of the test?

NPR. 5, 000 including VAT.

5. How do I register?

Go to the link https://www.britishcouncil.org.np/exam/foundation-english-test
Fill in the Microsoft form and submit. Check your email for registration confirmation.

The details provided in registration form should be same as in your ID document because amendment of details is not possible after you receive your registration confirmation email.

6. Payment details:

You will receive payment confirmation email within 2 to 3 working days after the payment is made and only if you submit all required documents.

7. I have made the payment, but I have not received payment confirmation email.

You will receive payment confirmation email within 2 to 3 working days of making the payment only after you send the scanned copy of deposit slip and ID document to fetnepal@britishcouncil.org. Do not forget to email scanned or digital copy of deposit slip and ID document.

8. What are the refund and transfer policy?

a) Test Date Transfers

- Candidates may request a transfer to the next available test date, subject to availability.
- A transfer fee of NPR. 500 will apply.
- Requests for transfer must be submitted at least a day prior to the scheduled test date.

b) Refund Eligibility

- Refunds shall be granted exclusively in cases of medical emergencies where the candidate unable to attend the scheduled test.
- No refunds shall be issued for any other reason, including but not limited to personal commitments, travel issues, or failure to appear for the test.

c) Documentation Requirements for Refund

- Candidates requesting a refund must provide a valid medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner.
- The certificate must clearly state the nature of the illness and confirm that the candidate is unable to attend the test.
- All documentation must be submitted within two days of the scheduled test date.

d) Refund Amount

 Approved refunds will be processed after deducting an administrative fee of NPR. 1250 from the test fee.

e) Processing Timeline

- Refunds and transfers will be processed within 14 days following approval of the request.
- The decision of the organisation regarding refunds and transfers shall be final and binding.

9. Does British Council conduct FET preparation classes?

10. Can I give FET test online from my home?

No. British Council conducts FET test in designated venue only in Kathmandu. Test details including test date, time and venue will be shared within two to three working days of payment confirmation.

11. I am currently out of Nepal. Can I give FET test from my current location?

No. FET test is conducted only in Kathmandu for now.

12. What to bring on the test day?

You need to bring a valid ID document you have mentioned during the registration (i.e. Passport/National ID/Citizenship Card) and stationaries (pen and pencil).

Do not carry any valuable belongings with you on the exam day as you will not be allowed to take these items into the exam hall.

13. When will results be published?

Results will be published in 48 hours after the test and the digital copy of the certificate will be emailed to the specified email address given during the registration. So, we encourage test takers to plan for your test accordingly.

14. I have not received my desired score. Can I retake my test?

Yes. You can retake the FET test if you complete registration before the registration deadline-
