> ACTIVITIES:

Formation of student council

After the workshop conducted by the British Council, we made an announcement in the assembly regarding the social action plan and asked the interested students to come forward and participate in the GEMS Student Council. Many students came up and volunteered for the council. There was selection among the interested students and board members were declared.

• Collection Of Fund

To get the grant from British Council, we had to organize a self- fund raising program. Then, we came to a conclusion of having a Inter- Section Poster making Contest. We conducted this contest in collaboration with the GEMS Social Service Club and collected a sum of Rs. 1500.

• Collection of the grant of 200£

GEMS was selected for the grant by the British Council. The coordinator with two other students went to receive it.

Decision for the venue of the project

We decided to carry out this project near the school so that the project would go on smoothly and easily and moreover it would not hamper our studies. A place called "Jhhonche tol" was selected because it was nearby to our school and also it was an enclosed with limited number of houses to work with.

Collection of the local's views

In our first visit, we collected the views of people regarding the garbage disposal in their community and found out that the condition was not satisfactory. We came to know that they burnt plastics and other non- degradable wastes and threw away other waste on land without any processing.

Division of the council into different hats & Brainstorming

We were determined to change the status of garbage management in that particular area. There was the division of group into De Bono's Six Hats in order to bring out new and argumentative ideas from the members' minds. In this way, we planned the activities for our project.

Meeting with the VDC Head

During the meeting, we asked for the permission to work in Jhhonche Tol and discussed about the garbage problems in that place. He allowed us to work and promised to help us in the project.

Discussion of the problem and its possible solutions

The members of the Student Council discussed about the problems and ways to tackle it. We planned to distribute dustbins in each house and teach them about degradable and non- degradable wastes along with the making of compost and the disposal of wastes in a healthy manner.

• Conduction of "Best Of Waste" exhibition

Along with the project, we focused on the upliftment of the students' attitude towards environment. So, we organized an exhibition of the materials that were made

out of waste materials and spread the message of 3R in the school. From this contest we collected a sum of Rs. 1270.

• Making of posters, flex and buying of dustbins

We designed the flex, posters and ordered them for printing. We also bought dustbins and other resources required.

• Visit to the place

The members of the Council visited the place and met with the elders and other people in the tol. We all explained them about our project and taught them about compost pits, use of healthy sanitation and distributed dustbins. We told them to be regular in proper disposal of wastes and asked them to maintain cleanliness in their area.

Regular monitoring

Each group were assigned areas for regular monitoring and as well as for helping them to practice healthy disposal of garbage.

The compost pit worked wonders on the lives of people. They can now use the fertilizers in their own kitchen garden. Beside these, the people also seemed to know more aware about the importance of cleanliness and sanitation in their life.

> Conclusion:

The first Social Action Project was undoubtedly a great experience for all the students. The students learnt some very important values like hard work, patience, ability to mingle with all types of people and along with it they were able to create a difference in society. Even though it was just a small tol with around 25 houses, it gave them the encouragement that they can do this in a large scale someday. The tol was also benefitted greatly.
