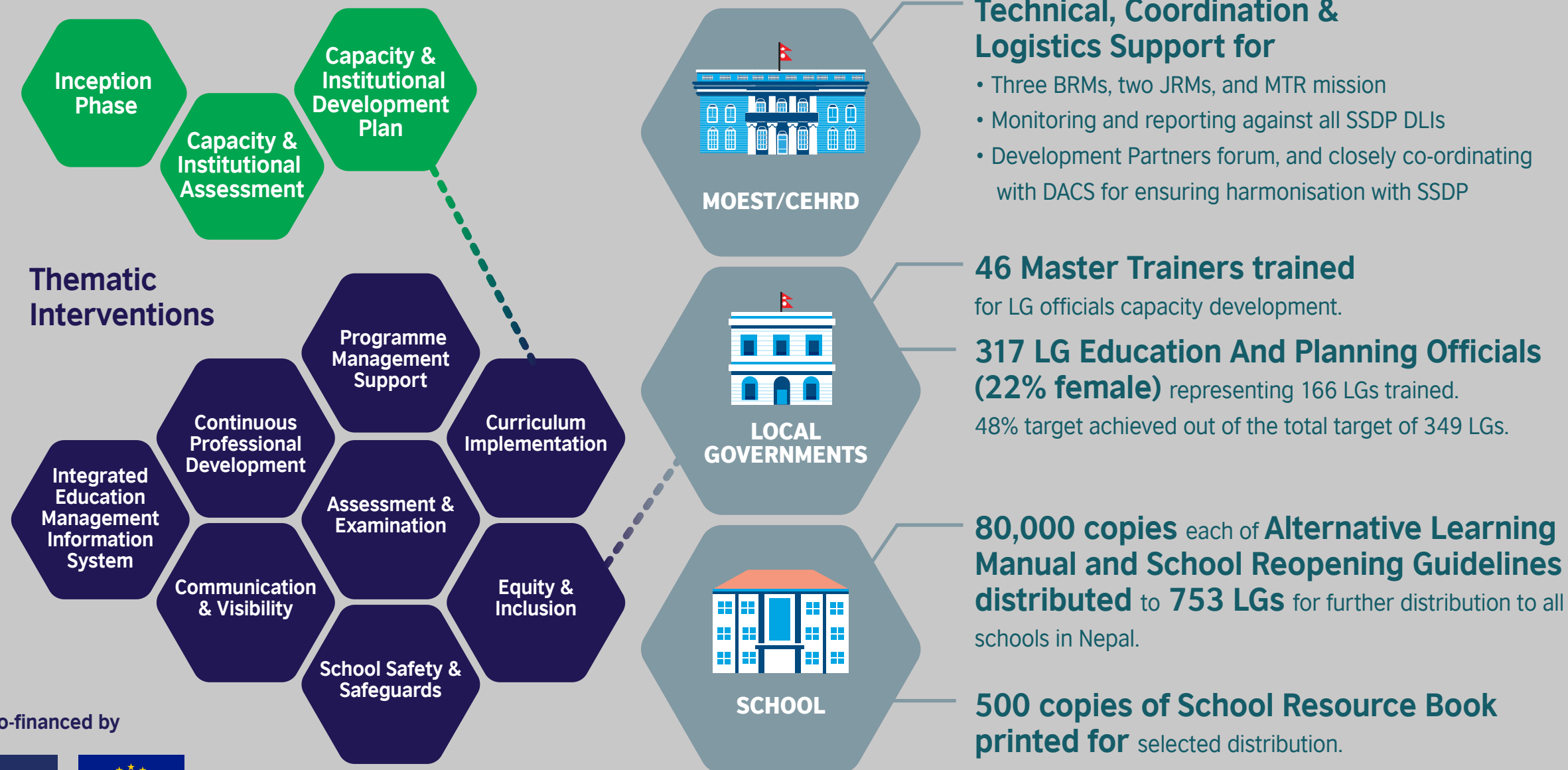

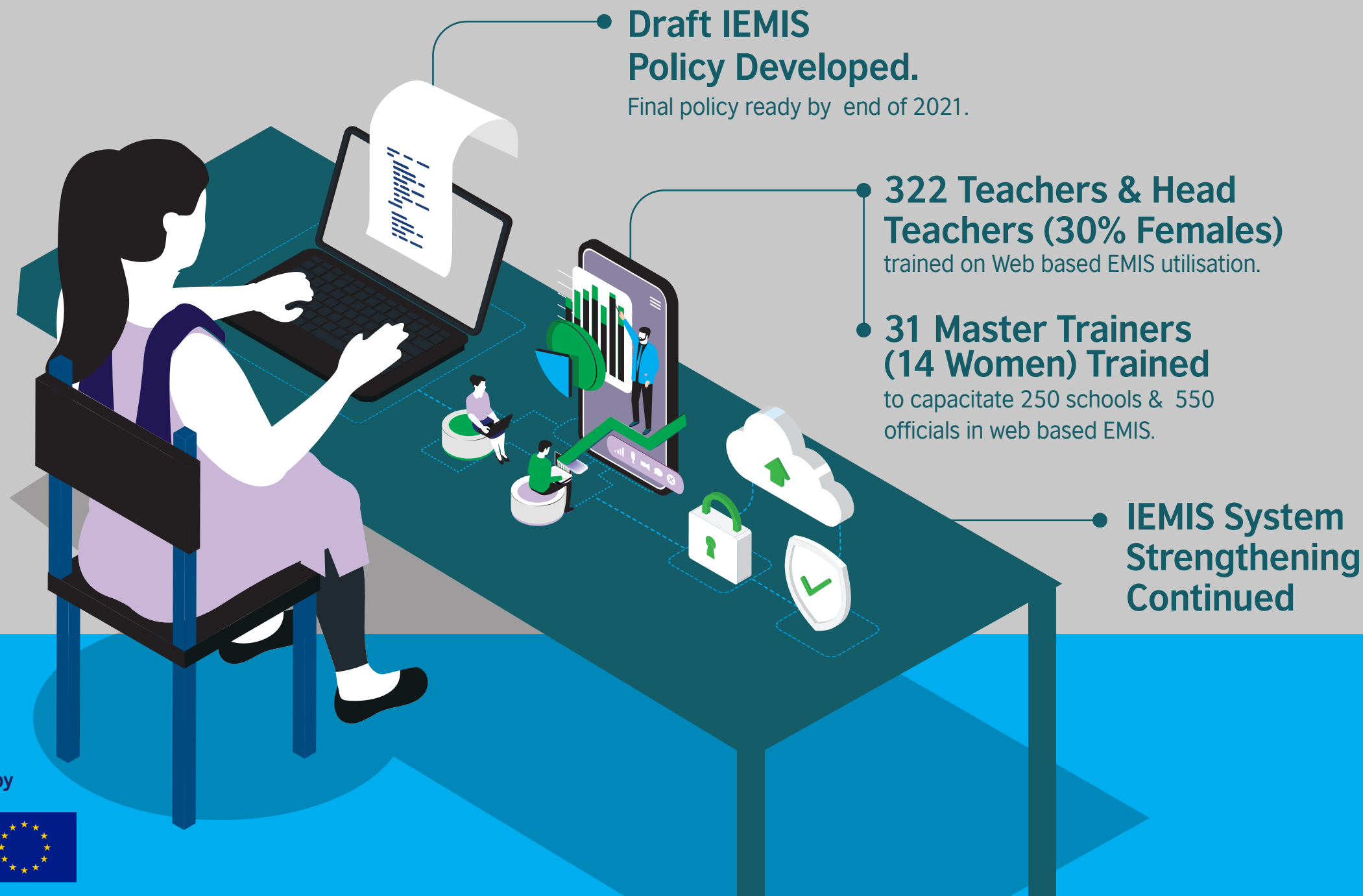

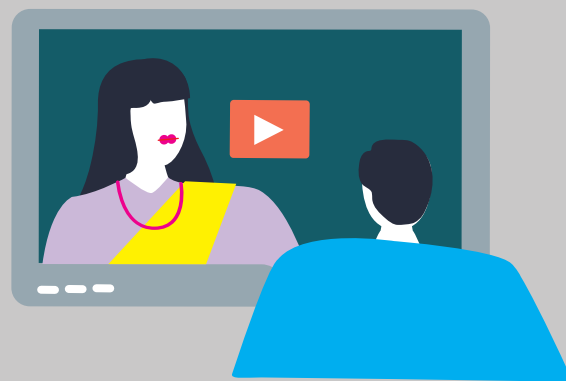




Teachers' Continuous Professional Development
